ELIGIBILITY

WSF events are open to all amateur players from around the world. The WSF welcomes players and officials of all nationalities and genders. Please see World Women's Snooker terms and conditions for eligibility, rules and entry fees for WSF Women's Championship events.

- Players are eligible to enter directly on an individual basis. WSF reserves the right to refuse entry to any player.
- Both events are mixed gender open events.
- Players for the Junior Championship must be under the age of 19 up to and including 23rd January 2026.
- Players for the Open Championship may be any age.

ENTRY PROCESS

All players must be entered through WPBSA SnookerScores (www.snookerscores.net), the official WSF Tournament Management system for the events.

ENTRY FEE


Please note an entry fee of €60.00 (euros) per player for the Junior Championship and Women's competition and €100.00 (euros) per player for the WSF Championship must be paid online through WPBSA SnookerScores before 1:00pm CET on Friday 9th January 2026.

THE VENUE & THE HOTEL

The championships will be played on Xing Pai (STAR) tournament professional tables, with further tables assigned for practice. All tables will be fitted with Strachan Superfine bed cloth together with tournament-standard lighting and 1G competition snooker balls.

Room Prices (euros) per night including Breakfast:

Single standard room – €120 (one hundred and twenty), including 9% VAT Double/Twin standard room – €140 (one hundred and forty), including 9% VAT Triple standard room (with an added folding bed) – €190 (one hundred and ninety), including **9% VAT**

There is an option to upgrade your accommodation to premium category rooms, this is an additional cost of €30 per room per night. Players/Guest can request this upgrade on arrival and is subject to availability.

A city tax of €1.67 per person per night is paid separately by guests and is not included in the room price. Accommodation for the full duration of stay (including any upgrades) must be paid in Euro currency at the hotel reception upon arrival (Credit, debit card or cash accepted).

- 1) After you have entered the event, click the main menu and then click "My Player"
- 2) Underneath your entry click the "Edit Travel Details" button
- 3) Complete the requested information for you and any guests.

Hotel / Travel data with flight details including return flight details must be submitted via WPBSA SnookerScores by:

WSF Junior / Women's Championship 1:00pm CET on Friday 9th January 2026. WSF Open Championship 1:00pm CET on Friday 16th January 2026.

Following receipt of your completed travel details, the WSF will arrange your hotel booking directly with the hotel.

PLEASE NOTE: Any player who enters the event and does not subsequently attend/compete, will be liable to the WSF for the first night of their booked accommodation. Should reasonable notice of withdrawal be given, players will be provided the opportunity to appeal against this cost. The WSF reserves the right to not accept future tournament entries from such players until payment has been received in full.

TRANSPORT

Transfers Airport/Hotel/Airport are available as follows:

Participants will be met at Sofia International airport by Bulgaria Snooker Federation (BSF) representatives upon arrival subject to your arrival information being correctly completed with your Travel details within WPBSA SnookerScores (www.snookerscores.net).

The transfer costs (Airport/Hotel Marinela/Airport) will be organised in Taxis for 2 to 3 persons at €20 per taxi/ one way to be paid upon arrival to the BSF representative at the airport or at the hotel for the return transfer.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Early round robin matches will be played over a minimum of best of five frames. Knock out stages will commence from at least the last 16 stage, however, subject to total entries WSF retains the right to extend the knockout stages to include more players, for example at the last 32 stage. Duration of matches for the knockout stages will be released at the time of issuing the draw and format of play. The draws for each event will not be published until the day before the start of each event.

DRESS CODE

The Dress code for the Junior and Open tournaments will be full formal dress code as approved by the WPBSA and World Snooker Tour, i.e., Waistcoat, bow tie, smart trousers, dress shirt and formal shoes with socks. Sport shoes and high boots are not acceptable. Please note that clothes must be clean and worn correctly. For further guidance please see the guide linked here.

Any applications for a dress code exemption must be received at least two weeks prior to the event starting.

PLAYER LOGOS -

Players are permitted to wear up to four of their own commercial logos, to cover an area no greater than 6 square inches (38.7 cm²) each. No more than two patches are worn on one side of a waistcoat and no more than one on each sleeve or their shirt. No player's sponsor shall conflict with the title sponsor of the Event or the WSF retained logo. One logo space must be reserved for the WSF event logo which will be provided to you on arrival at the event. This logo must be worn on the front of the waistcoat. Players may additionally wear a national flag of the country they are representing and/or their federation logo which will not count as one of the four sponsor logos. WSF retains the right to refuse any logo. No stacking of multiple logos down one side will be permitted, and the Tournament Director's decision is final.


